## Dissertation Research Award Application

The Northeast Counties Association of Psychologists (NCAP) Dissertation Research Awards program was established to assist and support doctoral students in psychology and early career psychologists in their research related to their dissertation project. NCAP promotes diversity and inclusion.

Application: To apply for a NCAP Dissertation Research Award, applicants must be doctoral students or early career psychologists within two years of completing their doctoral studies. Applicants must submit a completed, signed application together with the documentation listed below. Application deadlines will be February 1<sup>st</sup> of each calendar year. Applications received *after* the stated deadline date will not be eligible.

Applicants may receive an award of \$250.00, and there shall be up to four awards available per year. An applicant is eligible for one NCAP Dissertation Research Award and, if granted, is not eligible to apply for a second award. Only completed applications will be accepted for consideration and reviewed. In the event that application requests exceed available awards for a given year, awards will be determined by a majority vote of the NCAP Executive Board.

### Eligibility

Requirements: Applicants must be current members of NCAP. Annual membership for students is \$10 and for early career psychologists is \$30. NCAP membership applications are available at <https://northeastnjpsychassoc.org/>.

Awardees are expected to prepare a poster presentation of their findings during one of the NCAP program meetings (Winter, Spring, or Fall). Awardees will be acknowledged and recognized by the Executive Board during the program before the Membership, allowed time to present their work, and provided the awards at the time of their presentation.
